Novel Coronavirus - Basic preventive measures

Following measures have been suggested by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India and World Health Organization to prevent from getting infected:

- Use handkerchief / tissue over mouth while coughing / sneezing
- · Stay away from school when sick
- · Seek medical help if you have fever, cough or difficulty in breathing
- Stay informed and follow advice given by your doctor
- · Wear a mask if you are coughing or sneezing. Masks are effective only when used in combination with frequent hand-cleaning, with alcohol-based hand sanitizer / soap and water
